

NOTES FOR THE ORGANISER

1. Green Fees (inclusive of VAT) **£60.00 a round/per day for 12 or more Non-members**
2. Please note that each member of your party is required to have catering to a minimum value of £10.00. Catering charges, which are inclusive of VAT, are:

Please note that there is a minimum number of 14 for a function to proceed in the evening. However please enquire as we may have additional functions.

Please note you will be charged for meals booked, unless notified ONE DAY prior to your outing.

4. **Please note the following points:**

- a. The Society Dress Code must be observed.

Clubhouse

Tailored jacket, collar and tie must be worn in all areas of the Clubhouse except the Locker Room and Spike Bar where Casual Dress may be worn.

Casual Dress is defined as shirts with collars, polo shirts, sweaters, tailored trousers and shoes.

Unacceptable Casual Dress is defined as waterproofs, wet clothing, T-shirts, denim shirts or trousers, combat styles or jackets and trainers or sandals. No item of headgear is to be worn in the Clubhouse, including the Spike Bar.

Course

- (i) **Only tailored trousers may be worn. Jogging bottoms, jeans, tracksuits, combat styles and so forth are not acceptable.**
 - (ii) **Only collar attached sportshirts may be worn. Shirts are not to be worn over the waistline.**
 - (iii) **Shorts must be tailored and may only be worn with knee long hose.**
 - (iv) **Footwear is only to be golf shoes.**
- b. You are advised to secure your belongings in the lockers provided in the visitors changing room. Golf bags may be stored in the bag racks provided in the locker room.
 - c. Please drive with great caution in the car park.

5. Speed of play is very important and visitors are requested to go out in threes. **PLEASE INFORM YOUR PLAYERS THAT THEY MUST MOVE SMARTLY AND NOT HOLD UP THOSE BEHIND.**

6. **PLEASE ADVISE EVERYONE IN YOUR PARTY THAT MOBILE TELEPHONES ARE NOT TO BE USED IN THE CLUBHOUSE OR ON THE COURSE.**
