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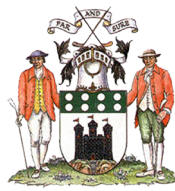

<b>26</b>	<b>Champagne Moet et Chandon Brut NV - France</b> <i>Aromas of white-fleshed fruits, citrus fruits, floral nuances and elegant notes. The palate is seductive, richly flavoured and smooth combining generosity and elegance.</i>			32.30
<b>27</b>	<b>Green Point Sparkling NV - Australia</b> <i>Floral notes with fig and subtle toasty aromas. Creamy and soft front palate, flavours of white peach, honey and roasted nuts blend harmoniously to create a complex wine with a refreshing dry finish. Fresh and delicious.</i>			17.60



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### *White Wines*

- 5 Mâcon Lugny Les Genièvres, Louis Latour 2006** 18.40  
BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
*Lugny is one of the top vineyards in southern Burgundy's Mâconnais region. An opulent and fruity Chardonnay with a flowery bouquet and crisp honey, apple and nutty flavours on the palate.*
- 6 J.J. Vincent Pouilly-Fuissé 2007** 19.00  
BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
*Melon, apple, and grapefruit mingle on the nose and palate, and a combination of bright citricity and chalky, stony nuances reminds one that this is from high-elevation Vergisson terroir. Very polished in texture, with a hint of creaminess, the wine finishes with a lovely balance of honeyed richness, citrus brightness, and mineral persistence.*
- 7 Chablis, Domaine Louis Michel & Fils 2007** 20.00  
BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
*Louis Michel et Fils are recognised not only in Chablis but internationally for producing one of the cleanest, richest and purest Chablis. This wine is a first class example of balanced, stylish Chablis - rich buttery fruit with refined elegant classic characteristics.*
- 8 Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Hubert Brochard 2008** 21.50  
LOIRE, FRANCE  
*The wine offers grapefruit, lime, spice and mineral notes. On the palate you find fresh citrus, honey, spices, minerals and even a hint of herbal teas. Over all this is beautifully balanced with good length.*
- 9 Meursault, Adamas 2006** 46.10  
BURGUNDY, FRANCE  
*Adamas Meursault has all the richness and complexity you would associate with this great village wine. Chardonnay from Meursault has a very attractive weight of fruit on the palate with a long, toasty finish with just a hint of buttery richness.*

| <b>12</b> | <b>Sauvignon Blanc Three Stone Estate, Marlborough 2008</b><br>NEW ZEALAND<br><i>A zesty and delicious wine. Flavours of passion fruit and gooseberry combine with mouth-watering acidity, creating a truly refreshing wine.</i>  | 16.60 |

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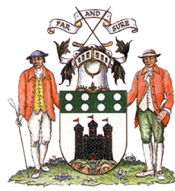
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### *Red Wines*

- 14 Chateau Lauriol (2nd Wine of Chateau Puygueraud) 2007** 16.60  
BORDEAUX, CÔTES DE FRANCS, FRANCE  
*This is an insider's secret, the "second" wine of Chateau Puygueraud, an overachieving property in the Cotes de Francs. Dark, ruby colour, powerful aroma of wild blackcurrants backed by an incredible soft palate – inky and rich – excellent claret.*
- 15 "Les Cent Rangs" Château Lagrange Les Tours 2003** 17.95  
BORDEAUX, FRANCE  
*Produced by Michel Choquet, a dedicated winemaker passionate about quality. Full bodied & complex this is really wonderful wine.*
- 16 Fleurie, Joseph Drouhin 2005** 20.45  
CRU BEAUJOLAIS, FRANCE  
*The true style of the Gamay grape made by a master of the genre– soft summer fruit flavours and juicy finish.*
- 17 Châteauneuf du Pape, Parcelles 38 2006** 28.45  
RHONE, FRANCE  
*Hearty Chateauneuf du Pape wine from a top producer. Leaps from the glass with expressive herby red fruit, clove and chocolate aromas. Rich, dark & robust. A powerful wine but with great finesse.*
- 18 Frank Phélan (2nd Wine of Château Phélan Ségur) 2005** 38.95  
SAINT ESTÈPHE, FRANCE  
*"One of the best – run estates of the St Estèphe appellation ...this property has been on a qualitative hot streak since the mid eighties" Robert Parker Wonderful blackcurrant, classic St Estephe nose which is beautifully forward and drinking perfectly now. Rich, soft, smooth as velvet claret - a joy.*
- 19 Ségla (2nd wine of Château Rauzan Ségla 2eme Cru Classé) 2002** 49.20  
MARGAUX, FRANCE  
*The second wine of the outstanding Rauzan Segla, one of Margaux's finest. A fine vintage – the wine is full bodied and robust with soft tannins and rich blackcurrant fruit.*
- 20 Campillo Rioja Reserva 2002** 22.00  
SPAIN  
*Deep, complex aromas with very developed hint of fruit, leather and vanilla. Beautiful mellow wine with well integrated oak flavours and a very long smooth finish.*





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- 21 **Malbec, Don Cristobal 2008** 14.90  
ARGENTINA  
*Fine and elegant aroma with a perfect combination of ripe red fruits and spices, enriched by the use of French oak. In the mouth it is balanced with soft tannins.*
- 22 **Rioja Crianza Vina Amate 2005** 15.90  
SPAIN  
*This Crianza was aged in American oak barrels for 12 months, with a further 12 months in bottle, creating a soft and smooth Rioja with hints of vanilla and chocolate on the nose. A good match with a rich meat casserole.*
- 23 **Springfontein Pinotage, Walker Bay 2006** 16.90  
SOUTH AFRICA  
*Springfontein is an organic estate to watch, keeping production low and literally hand-crafting the wines. Red cherry and raspberry with pine tar and a great acidic tingle. Ripe and very good*
- 24 **Merlot Reserva Santa Ema 2006** 16.40  
CHILE  
*Full bodied and robust with loads of ripe black fruits, liquorice, chocolate, coffee and vanilla that make it a pleasure to drink*

#### WHITE

- 28 **Chablis, Domaine du Colombier, Burgundy 2007** 12.00  
FRANCE  
*A perfect example of what can be done in the region. Pure and authentic wine vinified and aged in stainless steel tanks to retain all its freshness and mineral character.*

#### RED

- 29 **Cotes du Rhone Rouge, Parcelles 38, Vignobles Jerome Quiot 2007** 8.70  
FRANCE  
*Full flavoured with the structure to support the ample fruit. Delicious drinking now.*
